THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The container rates referred to in paragraph IV, subsections (c) and (d) of that certain Contract between City of Lebanon and The Spady-Redfield Corporation, effective February 6, 1972, set out in Ordinance No. 1425, are abolished, and the new rates are as follows:

DROP BOX RATES

\$20.00 per load - 20-yard drop box

\$80.00 minimum per month for regular use

\$ 1.00 demurrage for each day after 3 days for temporary use.

\$30.00 per load - 30-yard drop box

\$120.00 minimum per month for regular use

\$1.00 demurrage for each day after 3 days temporary use.

Section 2. Persons, firms and corporations who are not subscribers to the regular pickup service shall be charged the following amounts for the use of the City Landfill area:

\$0.50 for debris from a passenger car

\$0.50 minimum per station wagon, pickup or trailer for 2 receptacles or equivalent

\$0.25 for each additional receptacle

\$1.00 per station wagon, pickup or trailer load of loose material or debris

\$2.00 to \$5.00 per truck load, depending on size of load and/or number of receptacles or equivalent.

A receptacle is considered to be a 30-gallon size garbage can.

Section 3. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
