ORDINANCE NO. 1452


THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Recorder of the City of Lebanon are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a Contract with _____ MORSE BROS., INC. _____ for the paving of Sherman Street from Tenth Street West to the Drain Ditch (Cox Creek); Grant Place; Fifteenth Street from Maple Street to Sherman Street; Wassom Street from the end of existing paving east to Second Street; and "A" Street from Third Street East one-half block, and to obligate the City of Lebanon for the payment of \$ 57,642.93 for said stream improvement, and that the Contract shall refer to the plans and specifications heretofore filed by the City Engineer and approved by the Common Council, and shall be in the following form, to-wit:

Section 2. That inasmuch as this Contract is for the paving of streets, it is necessary for the peace, health and safety of the City of Lebanon that said work be done immediately; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
