ORDINANCE NO. 1453

WHEREAS a public hearing was held as provided in Ordinance No. 1442, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 222.120; and

WHEREAS, asprovided in ORS 222.170, at least two-thirds of the landowners of the property described below, who also own at least two-thirds of the land in said territory, which represents at least two-thirds of the assessed value of all real property in said territory, have, prior to the public hearing, consented in writing to the annexation and have filed a statement of their consent with the City Council; and

WHEREAS said real property is contiguous territory to the City of Lebanon,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following described property is hereby annexed to the City of Lebanon, Oregon, to-wit:

Beginning at the Northeast Corner of Lot 5, Block 1, ROBERTSON ADDITION, thence East along the South line of Ede's Addition 500 feet; thence South 0° 34' West 51.64 feet; thence South 22° 30' West 130.25 feet; thence along a 131.08 foot radius curve Southeasterly 51.47 feet through 22° 30' of arc (the chord bears South 56° 15' East 51.14 feet); thence West 500.75 feet to the Southeast Corner of Robertson Addition; thence North 0° 16' East 274 feet to the place of beginning.

ALSO: The South 61 feet of the West 70 feet of Lot 26 and the North 39 feet of the West 70 feet of Lot 32, except that portion already lying within the City Limits, and being a portion of Lots 26 and 32, HYLAND ADDITION, Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon.

Section 2. The City Recorder is hereby directed to make and submit to the Secretary of the State of Oregon a copy of this Ordinance,

together with a copy of the statement of consent of the landowners in said territory, and also a copy of Ordinance No. 1442 declaring that no election shall be required within the City of Lebanon.
