ORDINANCE NO. 1471

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City of Lebanon and Spady-Redfield Corporation contract, effective February 6, 1972, and set forth in Ordinance No. 1425, passed December 21, 1971, is amended as set forth below.

Section 2. Subparagraph (a) of paragraph IV of said Contract is amended to read as follows:

(a) Noncommercial/^{Commercial}rate - weekly pick-up

Effective March 1, 1973

One Standard Container
(not over 32 gallons) \$2.05 per month

Each additional Standard
Container \$1.50 per month


Effective August 1, 1973

One Standard Container
(not over 32 gallons) \$2.35 per month

Each additional Standard
Container \$1.50 per month


Section 3. Inasmuch as this increase in rate is necessary for the peace, health and safety of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
