THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1291 (compiled as 5-13.1) is amended by the addition of the following subparagraphs:

- "(4) Animal. Includes dogs, cats, but not other common domestic house pets, but includes all animals which, because of their size or temperament may threaten persons or property, if allowed to run at large, and includes, but not limited to, any cow, bull, horse, mule, donkey, sheep, pig or goat.
 - (5) Fowl. Includes, but not limited to, chickens, pigeons, ducks, turkeys, geese, or other domestic fowl."

Section 2. Section 12 is amended to read as follows:

"Animals, Bees, and Fowl. Except for household pets and by permit from the City Council or otherwise permitted by ordinance, no person shall keep or maintain animals, bees, or fowl within the city."
