

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING) ORDINANCE BILL NO. 37 FOR 1973
ORDINANCE NO. 1291 RELATING TO)
ANIMALS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY) ORDINANCE NO. 1498

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 12 of Ordinance No. 1291 (compiled as 5-13.1) is amended to read as follows:

"Animals, Bees, and Fowl. Except for household pets, OR by permit from the City Council when there is no objection by a person residing within 300 feet of the premises where the animals, bees, or fowl are to be kept, or where otherwise permitted by ordinance, no person shall keep or maintain animals, bees, or fowl within the city."

Section 2. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
