ORDINANCE BILL NO. 1 FOR 1974

ORDINANCE NO. 1499

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to the provisions of ORS 226.010 the Lebanon boat launching ramp and area known as "Gill's Landing" is declared to be a park and all police and/or penal ordinances and charter provisions necessary to protect and preserve the peace and order therein or to regulate the uses of such park are made applicable to said land, and the enforcement of said ordinances and provisions by penalties of fine or imprisonment and the power to make arrests and serve processes of Courts therein or upon persons therein or thereon may be made in like manner and with like effect as if the lands were within the Lebanon corporate city limits.

Section 2. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
