ORDINANCE NO. 1527

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS: <u>Section 1</u>. That the Mayor and the Recorder of the City of Lebanon are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a Contract with <u>Cordel Corporation</u> for the construction of a storm sewer drainage system in the area known as Twelfth Street Drainage District and for the construction of a sanitary sewer improvement on Twelfth Street from Vine Street to Tangent Street, and to obligate the City of Lebanon for the payment of \$<u>35,995.00</u> for said sewer construction, and that the Contract shall refer to the plans and specifications heretofore filed by the City Engineer and approved by the Common Council, and shall be in the following form, to-wit:

Section 2. That inasmuch as this Contract is for the construction of a storm sewer drainage system and sanitary sewer improvements, it is necessary for the peace, health and safety of the City of Lebanon that said work be done immediately; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
