ORDINANCE NO. 1528

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS: <u>Section 1</u>. That the Mayor and the Recorder of the City of Lebanon are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a Contract with <u>Corvallis Sand & Gravel</u> for the paving of Airway Road from Oak Street to Vine Street; Airway Place; Sherman Street from Greenway Street to Airway Road; Sixteenth Street from Sherman Street to Vine Street; Sixteenth Place; Maple Place; and Maple Street from Tenth Street to Twelfth Street; Eighth Street from Tangent Street to Harrison Street; and Vine Street from Seventh Street to Tenth Street, and to obligate the City of Lebanon for the payment of \$ 170,921.06 for said street improvement, and that the Contract shall refer to the plans and specifications heretofore filed by the City Engineer and approved by the Common Council, and shall be in the following form, to-wit:

Section 2. That inasmuch as this Contract is for the paving of streets, it is necessary for the peace, health and safety of the City of Lebanon that said work be done immediately; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
