THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Article IV (c) and (d) of the Lebanon Sanitation Company contract as set out in Ordinance No. 1425 as amended by Ordinance No. 1444 (compiled as 11-9.1) is amended to read as follows:

"Container rates and drop box rates as set forth in Subsections (c) and (d) below shall be effective and applicable to the city at large beginning October 1, 1974; provided however that with respect to tax supported institutions said rates shall become effective beginning July 1, 1975.

Section 2. That inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
