ORDINANCE NO. 1539

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Title of Ordinance. This ordinance shall hereafter be referred to and cited as the STREET TREE ORDINANCE of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

Section 2. Enforcing Authority. The City Engineer or his duly authorized representative shall be charged with the enforcement of this ordinance.

Section 3. Permission to Plant Trees. No trees or shrubs shall hereafter be planted in or removed from any public parking strip or other public place in the city without permission from the City Engineer.

Section 4. Street Tree Plan. All trees and shrubs hereafter planted in any public parking strip or other public place in the city shall conform as to species and location to the street tree plan which is hereby made a part of this ordinance.

Section 5. Prohibited Trees. It shall be unlawful to plant in any public parking strip the following trees:

Poplar	Cottonwood
Willow	Fruit Trees
Conifer	Nut Trees
Elm	Maple
Ailanthus	

It shall be unlawful to plant willow, cottonwood, or poplar trees anywhere in the city unless the City Engineer approves the site as one where the tree roots will not interfere with a public sewer.

Section 6. Removal of Trees. The City Engineer or his duly authorized representative may cause to be trimmed, pruned, or removed any trees, shrubs, plants, or vegetation in any parking strip or other public place, or may ~~require~~ ^{allow} any property owner to trim, prune, or remove
