



THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. A salaried or compensated City employee, or a salaried or compensated appointed City officer may not continue in such employment or office, and may not receive any such salary or compensation, while serving as Mayor or Councilman of the City of Lebanon.

Section 2. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 23rd day of December, 1974.
