PROPOSITION (1) IBER USA

Shall the City of Lebanon be authorized to levy a tax on property in the sum of \$380,864.00 outside the limitation imposed by Section 11, Article XI, Oregon Constitution, for the tax year 1975-76, to provide funds for the operation and maintenance of departments of the General Fund?

If this measure is approved, the operating budget to be financed by local taxes for the tax year 1975-76 will be \$15,792.00 greater than the operating budget financed by local taxes for the preceding year.

PROPOSITION (2)

Shall the City of Lebanon be authorized to levy a tax on property in the sum of \$23,120.00 outside the limitation imposed by Section 11, Article XI, Oregon Constitution, for the tax year 1975-76, to provide funds for the continuance of ambulance service in the City of Lebanon?

If this measure is approved, the operating budget to be financed by local taxes for the tax year 1975-76 will be \$10,370.00 greater than the operating budget financed by local taxes for the preceding year.

PROPOSITION (3)

Shall the City of Lebanon be authorized to levy a tax on property in the sum of \$ 21,670.00 outside the limitation imposed by Section 11, Article XI, Oregon Constitution, for the tax year 1975-76, to hire an administrative sargeant, and a half-time clerk-dispatcher to increase police patrol, crime prevention and burglary investigation services?

The 1974-75 operating budget contained no funds for this proposition.

PROPOSITION (4)

Shall the City of Lebanon be authorized to levy a tax on property in the sum of \$2,000.00 outside the limitation imposed by Section 11, Article XI, Oregon Constitution, for the tax year 1975-76, to pay half the cost (the other half being paid by the Lebanon Rural Fire Protection District) of equipping the second City ambulance with heart-monitoring equipment?

The 1974-75 operating budget contained no funds for this proposition.

PROPOSITION (5)

Shall the City of Lebanon be authorized to levy a tax on property in the sum of \$3,365.50 outside the limitation imposed by Section 11, Article XI, Oregon Constitution, for the tax year 1975-76, to pay 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ % of the cost of hiring a fulltime clerk-office manager for the Fire Department (the other 57 $\frac{1}{2}$ % of the cost being paid by the Lebanon Rural Fire Protection District)?

The 1974-75 operating budget contained no funds for this proposition.

PROPOSITION (6)

Shall the City of Lebanon be authorized to levy a tax on property in the sum of \$25,000.00 outside the limitation imposed by Section 11, Article XI, Oregon Constitution, for the tax year 1975-76, to provide funds to qualify for and match monies available to the City in connection with various State and Federal grant programs?

The 1974-75 operating budget contained no funds for this proposition.

Section 6. That inasmuch as the City of Lebanon will be without funds to maintain its services in the coming fiscal year unless the special election herein referred to can be held without delay, the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
