A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1283 RELATING TO TRAFFIC CONTROL, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE BILL NO. 24 FOR 1975
ORDINANCE NO. 1566

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 4 of Ordinance 1283 (compiled as 6-4.4) is amended to read as follows:

"(15) Yellow paint on curb. No parking zone.

(16) Orange paint on curb. Controlled parking zone."

Section 2. Section 12 of Ordinance 1283 (compiled at 6-4.12) is amended to read as follows:

"(6) A vehicle in an area that has been painted yellow for no parking and so signed or marked."

Section 3. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
