

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR AND THE RECORDER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PAVING OF OLIVE STREET FROM SECOND STREET TO THIRD STREET; TWELFTH STREET FROM OAK STREET TO F STREET; ACADEMY STREET FROM TENTH STREET TO ELEVENTH STREET; THIRD STREET FROM ROSE STREET TO VINE STREET; MARY STREET FROM THIRD STREET TO 1000 FEET WEST; CAROLINA STREET FROM TENTH STREET TO ELEVENTH STREET; ISABELLA STREET FROM TENTH STREET TO ELEVENTH STREET; HARMONY STREET FROM EDDIE STREET TO 560 FEET EAST, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 1571

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Recorder of the City of Lebanon are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a Contract with MORSE BROS. for curbing, gutters and paving on Olive Street from Second Street to Third Street, Twelfth Street from Oak Street to F Street, Academy Street from Tenth Street to Eleventh Street, Third Street from Rose Street to Vine Street, Mary Street from Third Street to 1000 feet West, Carolina Street from Tenth Street to Eleventh Street, Isabella Street from Tenth Street to Eleventh Street, and Harmony Street from Eddie Street to 560 feet East, and to obligate the City of Lebanon for the payment of \$ 78,288.20 for said street improvements, and that the Contract shall refer to the plans and specifications heretofore filed by the City Engineer and approved by the Council, and shall be in the following form, to-wit:

Section 2. That inasmuch as this Contract and the pavings of said streets is necessary for the peace, health and safety of the City of

Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 9th day of September, 1975.
