ORDINANCE NO. 1587

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 7 of Ordinance No. 1290 (compiled as 5-12.7)
is amended by adding thereto the following:

"(1) SWIMMING POOLS. Every person in possession or control of land within the city, either as owner, purchaser under contract, lessee, tenant or licensee; upon which is situated a swimming pool, shall at all times maintain on the lot or premises upon which such pool is located, a fence to prevent accidental or unauthorized access.

Said fencing shall completely surround such pool or premises and shall be of substantial construction not less than five (5) feet in height, measured from ground level on the exterior side of the fence. There shall be no openings, gaps, holes or similar openings larger than four (4) inches in any horizontal dimension. Structures or buildings may be used as part of such enclosure.

All gates or doors providing access to such pool, except from buildings or structures, shall be provided with self-latches and self-closing devices capable of keeping such gates or doors securely latched and closed at all times. Such devices shall be located not less than five (5) feet above the exterior grade of such gates or doors.

This section is not intended to prevent the use of other protective devices, subject to approval by the Building Official, provided the degree of protection is not reduced from that specified above.

Section 2. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
