THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Lebanon are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contractual agreement with MORSE BROS. for the resurfacing of streets within the City of Lebanon as outlined in street improvement project no. 1-1976, and to obligate the City of Lebanon for the payment of:

Item I

Class C Asphaltic concrete 1,836 tons at \$ Sixteen dollars and Fifty cents per ton (\$ 16.50) per ton.

Total Item I 30294.00

Item II

Class AR-4000 Asphalt for Tack Coat Spread at .07 gal./yd<sup>2</sup> 1909 gallons @ the price of \$ One dollars and 00 cents per gal. (\$ 1.00) per gal.

Total Item II 1909.00

Total Items I & II \$ 32203.00

Section 2. That inasmuch as this Contract and the resurfacing of said streets is necessary for the peace, health and safety of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this

Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
