A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO STATE REVENUE SHARING FUNDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. ORDINANCE BILL NO. 22 for 1977

ORDINANCE NO. 1644

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to the provisions of Senate Bill 11 (Oregon Legislative Assembly-1977 Regular Session), the City of Lebanon hereby elects to receive distribution of State Revenue Sharing Funds this fiscal year and each subsequent fiscal year as long as said funds are available hereafter.

Section 2. The City Recorder is authorized and directed to file a copy of this Ordinance with the Executive Department of the State of Oregon not later than July 31, 1977; and to publish notice of public hearings before the Budget Committee and the City Council prior to July 31, 1977, and to file with the Executive Department certifications of said meetings prior to said date.

Section 3. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
