A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE TIME AND PLACE OF REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 968, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. ordinance bill no. 28 for 1977

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Council of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, commencing with the July 13, 1977 meeting, shall hold its regular meetings at 12:30 p.m. on the second and fourth Wednesday of each calendar month at the Council Chambers of the City Hall, Main and Maple Streets in Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. 968, and all ordinances or parts of ordinances that are in conflict hereunder be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 3. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
