THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Sections 4, 5 and 6 (1) of Ordinance No. 1532 (compiled as 9-3.4, 903.5 and 9-3.6(1) are amended to read as follows:

Section 4.

- (1) The Uniform Building Code, 1976 Edition, as amended by the Oregon Structural Specialty Code and Fire and Life Safety Code (1976), and future amendments thereto, published by the International Conference of Building Officials, is adopted as the building code of the City.
- (2) The Uniform Code for the Abatement of Dangerous Buildings, 1976 Edition, published by the International Conference of Building Officials, is adopted by the City.

(1) Where the conditions imposed by a provision of the codes differ from those imposed by another ordinance, law, or regulation having application in the City, the provisions which is more restrictive shall govern.

Section 2. That inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor pro tem.
