THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to an initiative petition filed with the City Recorder, a special election is hereby called to be held on the 7th day of November, 1978, between the hours of 8:00 o'clock a.m. and 8:00 o'clock p.m. for the purpose of submitting to the electors of the City of Lebanon a proposition to adopt or reject an ordinance prohibiting the public showing or advertising of films rated "X" by the Motion Picture Association of America inside the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

Section 2. The Ballot Title of the Proposition shall be as follows:

"A proposition submitted to the legal electors of Lebanon by initiative petition at a special election to be held November 7, 1978, for the adoption or rejection of an ordinance prohibiting the public showing or advertising of films rated "X" by the Motion Picture Association of America inside the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

Section 3. The Proposition shall be as follows:

"Shall an Ordinance be enacted prohibiting the public showing or advertising of films rated "X" by the Motion Picture Association of America inside the City of Lebanon, Oregon.


Section 4. The election polling places designated in the City of Lebanon by the Linn County Clerk for the state-wide election on November 7, 1978, are hereby designated as polling places for this special election; the poll books adopted for Lebanon by the Linn County Clerk as the poll books for said election are hereby adopted as the poll books for the special election; the Judges and Clerks of Election appointed by the Linn County Clerk to serve in Lebanon at said state-wide election are hereby designated as the Judges and Clerks of and for the City special election.

Section 5. The polls for the City special election shall be open in each of the voting precincts during the same hours as the polls are open and closed for the said state-wide election.

Section 6. The City Recorder is hereby authorized and directed to publish and post notices of said special election and propositions in the manner provided by law; and the propositions shall be placed upon the Official State Ballot or Special City Ballot, as may be permitted or required by law, to be voted upon by the legal electors of the City at said election.

Section 7. Inasmuch as it is necessary to immediately prepare the materials for submission to the County Clerk, to post notices, and to prepare and distribute voters pamphlets, and this ordinance being deemed necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
