INSIDE THE CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON. )

ORDINANCE NO. 1711-A

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the public showing, displaying or advertising of films rated "X" by the Motion Picture Association of America, whether for profit or non-profit, is prohibited inside the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

Section 2. Violation of this ordinance shall be a Misdemeanor. Additionally, the City Council, upon a violation of this ordinance, may revoke or refuse to issue the licenses provided for in Ordinance No. 909.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect December 8, 1978.

Passed by a majority vote of the electors of Lebanon at an election held on November 7, 1978.
