ORDINANCE BILL NO. 50
for 1978

ORDINANCE NO. 1714

WHEREAS there has been filed with the City of Lebanon a written petition for the annexation of the area described below; and

WHEREAS the City Charter of the City of Lebanon does not expressly prohibit the City from dispensing with submitting the question of annexation to the registered voters of the City; and

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of ORS 222.120, the City Council has elected to dispense with submitting the question to the registered voters and in lieu thereof to declare the territory annexed by Ordinance following the public hearing on the question,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: A public hearing shall be held at 8:00 p.m. on the 25th day of October, 1978, in the Council Chambers of the City Hall in the City of Lebanon, County of Linn, State of Oregon, before the Common Council of said City, at which time and place the registered voters of the City of Lebanon may appear and be heard on the question of the annexation of the following described area, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the North line of and West 1,032.42 feet from the Northeast corner of the Moses Bland Donation Land Claim No. 50, Township 12 South, Range 2 West of the Willamette Meridian, in Linn County, Oregon; thence West 30 feet; thence South along the West line of the East half of the East half of said Donation Land Claim No. 50, 3,135.10 feet to the South line of said Donation Land Claim No. 50; thence East along said South line 1,066.9 feet to the Southeast corner; thence North along the East line of said Donation Land Claim No. 50, to a point that is 1260 feet South along said East line of said Donation Land Claim No. 50 from the Northeast corner of said Donation Land Claim No. 50; thence West parallel with the North line of said Donation Land Claim No. 50 a distance of 1034.71 feet to a point that is 30 feet east of the West line of the East half of the East half of said Donation Land Claim No. 50; thence North 1260 feet to the Place of Beginning, Linn County, Oregon.

AND ALSO, that portion of Market Road #11, also known as Oak Street, immediately adjacent to the southern boundary of the above described parcel.


To be zoned M-L, Light Industrial, upon annexation.

and whether or not the Common Council shall dispense with submitting the question to the registered voters of the City of Lebanon.

Section 2: The Recorder of the City of Lebanon is hereby directed to publish a notice of this hearing once weekly for two successive weeks prior to the day above set for the hearing, in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Lebanon, and the Recorder shall post notices of the hearing in four public places in the City for a like period of time.


Section 3: Conditions are such that said annexation, if allowed, should be made within the near future, and, it being necessary for the peace, health and general welfare of the residents of the City of Lebanon that said hearing be held as soon as possible, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
