

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE) ORDINANCE BILL NO. 13
ZONING ORDINANCE NO. 1428, REZONING) for 1979
AN AREA AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.)
) ORDINANCE NO. 1736

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Pursuant to Article 8 of Ordinance No. 1428, and as initiated by the City Council, by the Planning Commission and by application of the property owner, and upon compliance with the requisites of said Article 8, the following amendment is made:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of the intersection between Hansard Avenue and Harrison Street in Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon; thence West along the South boundary of Harrison Street 319.13 feet to the Northwest corner of that tract conveyed to Lyle Moore in Volume 170, page 503, in Linn County Deed Records; thence South along the East boundary of said tract 136.0 feet; thence East parallel with Harrison Street 320 feet to the West boundary of Hansard Avenue; thence North along said West boundary 136.0 feet to the place of beginning. SAVE AND EXCEPT that portion of the above described tract of land lying within the boundaries of public roads and highways.


is changed from zone classification Multiple Family Residential (R-M) to Light Industrial (M-L).

The Zoning Map shall be amended to disclose said zoning change in compliance herewith and dated pursuant to Section 2.060 of said Ordinance.

Section 2. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
