ORDINANCE NO. 1738

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 909, enacted September 6, 1955 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. General Requirements and Exceptions: No person shall engage in a business or occupation or operate a device mentioned in the schedule of fees in this Ordinance unless such person first obtains from the City a license to do so. The requirements of this Ordinance shall not apply, however, to activities carried on for religious, educational, charitable or non-profit purposes."

Section 2. Section 8(30) of Ordinance No. 909 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(30) Professional wrestling or professional boxing exhibitions.

6% of gross from admission charges, excluding federal tax."

<u>Section 3.</u> Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
