A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1291 RELATING TO THE KEEPING OF ANIMALS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. ORDINANCE BILL NO. 27 for 1979 ORDINANCE NO. 1749

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Ordinance No. 1291, as amended, is hereby amended to add a new section 17 as follows:

"Section 17. Notwithstanding Section 12 above, if a person keeps or maintains animals on real property not located in the City, and such property is annexed into the City, said person may continue to keep or maintain animals on said annexed property so long as the following conditions and criteria are met and continue to be met:

- That the annexation was not requested by the owner of the property;
- (2) That the annexed real property is owned and occupied by the owner thereof on the date of annexation and continues to be so owned and occupied;
- (3) That the extent to which said real property was used or occupied by animals on a date one year immediately preceding the date of the annexation is not, or has not been, substantially changed at any time thereafter;
- (4) That no health or safety hazard to any other person would exist if animals are kept or maintained on said real property."

<u>Section 2</u>. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
