FINDINGS OF FACT.

The Planning Commission and Common Council of the City of Lebanon have given notice and held public hearings on the Lebanon, Oregon Comprehensive Plan; and

The Linn County Planning Commission and Board of Commissioners have given notice and held public hearings on the Lebanon, Oregon Comprehensive Plan.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the document dated February 27, 1980, and as amended March 5, 1980, as prepared by Morgan, Driscoll Associates, entitled "Lebanon, Oregon Comprehensive Plan" on file in the City of Lebanon Recorder's office and accompanying maps be adopted by the Council of the City of Lebanon; and

Section 2. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
