THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following street to-wit:

That portion of Maple Street right-of-way in the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, lying between the East line of Grove Street right-of-way and the West line of Williams Street right-of-way, all being a portion of J. M. Ralston's Third Addition to Lebanon, Oregon.

SAVE AND EXCEPT a 20 foot public utility easement of even width measured from and parallel to the Southerly right-of-way line of Maple Street.

be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval of the Mayor.

Passed by the Council by a vote of 4 for 1 against and approved by the Mayor this 9th day of July, 1980.

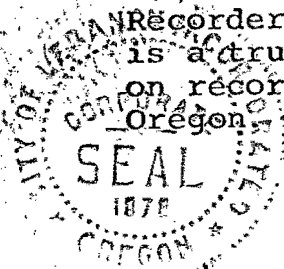
