

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO AMBULANCE  
SERVICE, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1257,  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. )

ORDINANCE NO. 1815

THE CITY OF LEBANON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Authorization. The City of Lebanon is authorized to maintain and operate an ambulance service for the assistance of ill and injured persons within and without the City.

Section 2. Records. The ambulance service shall be under the general supervision and control of the City Administrator and he or his designate shall keep adequate records thereof and shall make such reports to the Council as it may require.

Section 3. Rates. The City Council shall prescribe by resolution, the rates for such service.

Section 4. Repeal. Ordinance No. 1257 is hereby repealed.

Section 5. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

Passed by the Council by a vote of 5 for and 0 against and approved by the Mayor this 27<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1980.
