AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE STATUTES OF THE STATE OF OREGON REGARDING ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR, AND REPEALING ORDINANCES NO. 1287, 1304, and 1356. ORDINANCE BILL NO. 51 for 1980 ORDINANCE NO. 1817

THE CITY OF LEBANON ORDAINS AS. FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. ORS Chapter 471 known as the "Liquor Control Act" and ORS Chapter 472 known as the "Oregon Distilled Liquor Control Act" as hereafter amended are hereby incorporated by reference into this Ordinance as though fullyset forth herein, and any violation or failure to comply with such provisions shall be a violation of this Ordinance.

Section 2. Ordinances No. 1287, 1304 and 1356 are hereby repealed.
