THE CITY OF LEBANON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> <u>Adoption of Oregon Revised Statutes</u>. The following sections of Oregon Revised Statutes, along with any amendments thereto are incorporated by reference into this ordinance as though fully set forth herein.

## Section 2. Effect of Regulations.

- (1) This ordinance shall apply whenever a bicycle is operated upon a street or other public place within the City.
- (2) Every person riding a bicycle upon a street or public path within the City shall be subject to the provisions of this Chapter applicable to the driver of a motor vehicle, except those provisions which by their very nature can have no application.
- Section 3. Riding Single File. Persons riding bicycles shall ride in single file on a roadway or alley whenever a motor vehicle is approaching within one-hundred (100) feet to the rear.

Section 4. Racing. No person shall engage in, or cause others to be engaged

in, bicycle racing upon the streets or other public property in this City, except as sanctioned by the City Council.

Section 5. Emerging from Alley or Driveway. The operator of a bicycle entering or emerging from an alley, driveway, or building shall, upon approaching a sidewalk or the sidewalk area extending across any alley or driveway, yield the right-of-way to all pedestrians approaching on the sidewalk or sidewalk area, and upon entering the roadway, shall yield the right-of-way to all vehicles approaching on the roadway.

## Section 6. Riding on Sidewalks.

- (1) No person shall ride or operate a bicycle upon a sidewalk in that area bounded by the outer limits of Vine Street on the north, Park Street on the east, Oak Street on the South, and Second Street on the West.
- (2) A person riding a bicycle upon a sidewalk shall yield the right-of-way to pedestrians.

<u>Section 7. Parking.</u> No person shall park a bicycle upon a street or sidewalk except in a rack. If no rack is provided, the bicycle shall be parked in such manner as to afford the least obstruction to pedestrian and vehicular traffic.

<u>Section 8.</u> <u>Bicycle Dealers.</u> Persons engaged in the business of buying second hand bicycles shall maintain a record of every bicycle purchased, giving the name and address of the person from whom purchased, a description of the bicycle by name or make, the frame number thereof and the registration number, if any, found thereon.

Section 9. Rental Agencies. A rental agency shall not rent or offer a bicycle for rent unless the bicycle is licensed as required herein and is equipped with all equipment required by the motor vehicle laws of Oregon and this Ordinance.

Section 10. Parental Responsibility. No parent of a minor child and no quardian of a minor ward shall authorize or knowingly permit the minor child or ward

to violate this ordinance.

## Section 11. License Required:

(1) No person who resides within this City shall ride or propel a bicycle on any street or upon any public path set aside for the exclusive use of bicycles unless such bicycle has been licensed as herein provided. Applications for such license shall be made to the Police Department which shall issue a license to be effective for as long as the applicant may own the bicycle, providing the applicant submits satisfactory proof of ownership. There shall be charged for such license a license fee, the amount of which shall be set by the Council from time to time by resolution, and made a part hereof as if set forth herein.

The license tag shall be affixed to the rear upright frame member of the bicycle so licensed by the person issuing the license. Said license tag shall be displayed continuously on the bicycle during the term of the license.

(2) In order to provide adequate time for the citizens of Lebanon to be made fully aware of the provisions of sub-section (1) above, no person shall be required to comply with said provisions until January 1, 1981.

## Section 12. Penalties.

- (1) Violation of this ordinance shall constitute a Class D traffic infraction and shall be punished as provided for in ORS 484.350 through 484.360.
- (2) In lieu of or in addition to the penalty imposed under subsection (1), bicycles may be impounded for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days.
