

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CALLING OF A SPECIAL ELECTION IN THE CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON, ON FEBRUARY 17, 1981, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON, THE QUESTION OF WHETHER OR NOT THE CITY OF LEBANON SHALL BE AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS.

ORDINANCE NO. 1826

THE CITY OF LEBANON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Date of Election. The measure set forth in Section 2 of this Ordinance shall be submitted in the manner prescribed herein to the legal voters of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, at a special election to be held on February 17, 1981.

Section 2. Form of Question. At the special election, the following measure shall be submitted to the legal voters of the City of Lebanon for their approval or rejection:

GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND ISSUE
FOR PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS

Shall the City of Lebanon be authorized to issue up to \$2,100,000.00 in General Obligation Bonds?

Purpose: These funds will help pay for street improvements, storm drains, sewer lines, and other public improvements in the area of South Main Road, Walker Road, Airport Road, and Second Street. A portion of the total project cost will be paid by property owners in the project area. It is anticipated that approximately \$1,000,000.00 of this bond issue will be repaid with tax increment funds derived from an Urban Renewal District created for this area.

Section 3. Notice of Election. Notice of this special election shall be given by publication twice in the Lebanon Express, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Lebanon, Oregon not more than thirty nor less than ten days before the election.

Section 4. The City Recorder shall advertise the notice required by Section 3.

of this Ordinance, and such notice shall constitute the only notice necessary. There shall be no requirement for publication or furnishing of election pamphlets containing arguments in support of or in opposition to the question, or the text of the question itself.

Section 5. The polling places for said election in the City of Lebanon shall be those designated by the Linn County Clerk for special elections, the poll books adopted for Lebanon by the Linn County Clerk as the poll books for said election are hereby adopted as the poll books for the special election; the Judges and Clerks of election appointed by the Linn County Clerk to serve in Lebanon at said special election are hereby designated as the Judges and Clerks of and for the City special election.

Section 6. The polls for the City special election shall be open from the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on said day.

Section 7. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

Passed by the Council of the City of Lebanon by a vote of 4 for and 0 against and approved by the Mayor this 17th day of December, 1980.
