A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1800 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 12

ORDINANCE NO. 1838

THE CITY OF LEBANON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. Ordinance No. 1800, enacted August 13, 1980, is hereby amended to add the following Statutes to the list of Oregon Revised Statutes incorporated by reference in said Section 3:

ORS 135.290, 161.685, 162.295, 162.335, 163.575, 164.065, 164.085, 164.095, 165.037, 165.047, 166.025 (excepting Section (1)(c) thereof), 166.370, 166.510, 167.222, 167.850.

<u>Section 2</u>. Said Ordinance No. 1800 is further amended to add the following as Section 14 of the Ordinance:

"Section 14. Assault on a Police Officer

- (1) No person shall intentionally, knowingly or recklessly assault or commit a battery upon a Police Officer while said Officer is acting in the performance of his or her duties.
  - (2) In any prosecution under this Section, it shall not be necessary to show that the victim in urred any physical injury as a result of the assault or the battery."

<u>Section 3</u>. Ordinance No. 1800 is further amended to add the following as Section 18 of the Ordinance:

"Section 18. Interfering in Emergencies

It is unlawful for any person to stop or remain in the vicinity of a fire, explosion, accident, or similar emergency or disaster or where such an emergency or disaster is threatened, or in the vicinity of a riot, affray or arrest, when his presence may be unsafe to himself or others, or may interfere with rescue, fire-fighting or other emergency aid, after being notified by a peace officer to move to a place outside the area of danger or interference."

<u>Section 4</u>. It is necessary for the health, safety, comfort and convenience of the people of the City of Lebanon that this Ordinance have immediate effect. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be

in full force and effect upon	its passage and approval.
