ORDINANCE NO. 1849

THE CITY OF LEBANON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That it is the intention of the City Council of the City of Lebanon to cause street, sidewalk and storm drainage improvements in accordance with the Engineer's Preliminary Report, to which report reference is hereby made for estimated costs thereof, and to assess upon each lot, or part thereof, its proportionate share of the cost of said improvement and such costs shall become liens against the property. Said Engineer's Preliminary Report is incorporated herein by reference and the City hereby agrees to the terms thereof.

Section 2. That the boundary of this district, known as the "A" Street Local Improvement District shall be:

AMENDED BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION

Beginning at the Northwest corner of Block 4, William Ralston's Addition to Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon and running thence South $31^{\circ}05'94''$ East 308.18 feet; thence North 9.00 feet to a point on the North right-of-way line of the Lebanon-Santiam Canal; thence Northeasterly along said right-of-way line to the West line of Main Street; thence North 182.50 feet, more or less, to the original main track centerline of the Southern Pacific Transportation Company's Woodburn-Springfield Branch; thence Westerly along said centerline to a point North $67^{\circ}44'46''$ East 24.21 feet from the intersection of the North line of "A" Street with the East line of Second Street; thence South $67^{\circ}44'46''$ West 24.21 feet; thence South 60.00 feet to the point of beginning.

Section 3. The City Council hereby directs that the City Recorder shall cause detailed plans, specifications and construction drawings to be prepared and presented to the Council for their approval.

Section 4. That once said plans, specifications and construction drawings are approved by the Council, the City Recorder shall properly invite bids for the improvements.

Section 5. It is necessary for the health, safety, comfort, and convenience of the people of the City of Lebanon that this ordinance have immediate effect. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval.
