ORDINANCE NO. 1865

THE CITY OF LEBANON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1283, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. Amendments.

In addition to the Chapters and provisions of Oregon Revised Statutes adopted in Section 1 of this Ordinance, there are hereby adopted all the amendments to said Chapters and Sections that have been enacted by the State of Oregon as of October 28, 1981, including those amendments which have been enacted but have not yet taken effect."

Section 2. The first and last sentences of Section 3 of Ordinance No. 1800 are hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 3.

The following provisions of Oregon Revised Statutes, together with all amendments thereto that have been enacted as of October 28, 1981, including amendments enacted but not yet effective, are incorporated by reference into this Ordinance as though fully set forth herein, and any violation or failure to comply with such provisions shall be a violation of this Ordinance:

* * * * *

There are also hereby incorporated by reference, any definitions, sections, or provisions of Oregon Revised Statutes Chapters 161, 162, 163, 164, 165, 167 and 475, including any amendments thereto which have been enacted as of October 28, 1981, including any amendments which have been enacted but are not yet effective, which reasonably apply to the Statutes incorporated hereinabove."

Section 3. It is necessary for the health, safety, comfort and convenience of the people of the City of Lebanon that this Ordinance have immediate effect. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval.
