THE CITY OF LEBANON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. Chapter 10.28 of the Lebanon Municipal Code is hereby amended to add a new section 10.28.105 as follows:

"10.28.105. Parking Time Limits in Downtown Areas.

No person shall stop, stand, or park a vehicle for a continuous period of more than two (2) hours Monday through Saturday (except holidays) from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on the following streets:

Park Street from Oak Street to Vine Street Main Street from Oak Street to Vine Street Vine Street from 2nd Street to Park Street Ash Street from 2nd Street to Park Street Sherman Street from 2nd Street to Park Street Grant Street from 2nd Street to Park Street Maple Street from 2nd Street to Park Street

and the following public parking lots:

Grant and Main Street parking lot Vine and Main Street parking lot

The penalty for violation of this Section shall be \$5.00 for the first violation within a thirty (30) day period and \$10.00 for a second or subsequent violation within such period."

<u>Section 2.</u> It is necessary for the health, safety, comfort and convenience of the people of the City of Lebanon that this Ordinance have immediate effect. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
