ORDINANCE NO. 1893

THE CITY OF LEBANON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 10.56 of the Lebanon Municipal Code is hereby amended
to read as follows:

"10.56


The following Chapters and Provisions of Oregon Revised Statutes
are incorporated by reference into the Ordinance codified at this
title as though fully set forth in this Section, and any violation
or failure to comply with such Chapters or Provisions shall be a
violation of this title: Chapters 481, 482, 483, 484, 485, 486,
487, and 153. Additionally, there are incorporated by reference
any other Sections or Provisions of Oregon Revised Statutes relating
to punishment for violations of the Motor Vehicle Laws incorporated
in this Section. The City Attorney shall have the authority to
prosecute violations of this title on behalf of the City."

Section 2. Section 10.56.010 of the Lebanon Municipal Code is hereby
amended to read as follows:

"Unless provided otherwise in the provisions of Oregon Revised Statutes
incorporated above, a violation of this title shall constitute a traffic
infraction and shall be punishable as provided by ORS Chapter 153."


Section 3. It is necessary for the health, safety, comfort and convenience
of the people of the City of Lebanon that this Ordinance have immediate effect.
Therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be
in full force and effect upon its passage and approval.
