THE CITY OF LEBANON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 6.16.010 of Chapter 6.16 of the Lebanon Municipal Code is repealed in its entirety.


Section 2. In place of the provisions repealed hereinabove, the following language is adopted as Section 6.16.010 of Chapter 6.16 and shall be so designated in the Lebanon Municipal Code:

6.16.010: Restrictions on keeping:


Except for dogs, cats and other household pets, or by permit from the City Administrator or City Council when there is no objection by a person residing within three hundred feet of the premises where the animals, bees or fowl are to be kept, or where otherwise permitted by ordinance, no person shall keep or maintain animals, bees or fowl within the City.

Section 3. The provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the City of Lebanon and an emergency is therefore declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

Passed by the Council of the City of Lebanon by a vote of 5 for and 0 against and approved by the Mayor this 26<sup>th</sup> day of January, 1983.
