THE CITY OF LEBANON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a special election be held in the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon on the 26th day of June, 1984 for the purpose of submitting a proposed tax levy in excess of the tax base.

Section 2. At the special election the following measure shall be submitted to the legal electors of the City of Lebanon for their approval or rejection:

ONE YEAR SPECIAL LEVY

Question: Shall the City of Lebanon levy \$393,588 outside the tax base for 1984-85?

Statement: This measure is necessary for support of the Police and Fire Departments; a portion of this levy will also be used for street repairs and for City operations. If this measure is approved, the City's General Fund budget will be approximately 2.4% higher than for the current year. The total amount of money to be raised by this levy is \$393,588.


Section 3. The City Recorder is directed to file this ballot title with the office of the Linn County Clerk in accordance with ORS 310.330.

Section 4. The polling places for said election in the City of Lebanon shall be those designated by the Linn County Clerk for special elections; the poll books adopted for Lebanon by the Linn County Clerk as the poll books for said election are hereby adopted as the poll books for the special election; the Judges and Clerks of election appointed by the Linn County Clerk to serve in Lebanon at said special election are hereby designated as the Judges and Clerks of and for the City Special election.

Section 5. The polls for the City special election shall be open from the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on said day.


Section 6. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

Passed by the Council of the City of Lebanon by a vote of 5 for and 0 against and approved by the Mayor this 23rd day of May, 1984.
