A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING AND ZONING PROPERTY FOLLLOWING HEARING AND UPON THE WRITTEN CONSENT FILED WITH THE CITY COUNCIL BY LANDOWNERS IN SAID AREA, PURSUANT TO ORS 222.120 and ORS 222.170 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 1936

WHEREAS, there has been submitted to the City of Lebanon written requests for annexation to the City signed by more than one-half of the landowners who also own more than one-half of the land in the contiguous territory described below. Which real property represents more than one-half of the assessed value of all real property in the contiguous territory to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1933 was passed, initiating the annexation of the territory, calling a hearing and directing that notice be given; and

WHEREAS, after conducting the hearing and considering all objections or remonstrances with reference to the proposed annexation, the City Council finds that this annexation is in the best interest of the City and of the contiguous territory; NOW THEREFORE,

THE CITY OF LEBANON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Annexation Area. The following contiguous territory is hereby proclaimed to be annexed to the City of Lebanon and zoned as indicated in accordance with the Lebanon Zoning Ordinance No. 1773, and given the zoning of ML Limited Industrial:

Beginning at a 5/8 inch iron rod which is South 495.74 feet and South 45°31'00" West 2002.50 feet from the northeast corner of the James Ridgeway Donation Land Claim No. 46 in Township 12 South and Range 2 West of the Willamette Meridian in Linn County, Oregon, said rod also being on the northerly right-of-way of the Southern Pacific Railroad; and running thence North 44°36'38" West a distance of 235.88 feet to the easterly right-of-way of Market Road No. 24; thence southwesterly along a 1607.02 foot radius curve left (the long chord of which bears South 21°10'55" West 17.68 feet) a distance of 17.68 feet; thence South 20°52'00" West 374.83 feet; thence southwesterly along a 1402.40 foot radius curve left (the long chord of which bears South 17°40'51" West 155.88 feet) a distance of 155.96 feet to said northerly right-of-way; thence North 45°27'22" East 495.15 feet to the true point of beginning.

Section 2. Record. The City Recorder shall submit to the Oregon Secretary of State a copy of this Ordinance. The City Recorder shall also need a description by metes and bounds or legal subdivision, and a map depicting the new boundaries of the City within ten (10) days of the effective date of this annexation to the Linn County Assessor, Linn County Clerk and the State Department of Revenue.

<u>Section 3</u>. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon it passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
