A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 12.04 OF THE LEBANON MUNICIPAL CODE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF LEBANON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> 12.04.220 of the Lebanon Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Upon City Council approval of all assessments, the City Recorder shall mail notice to all affected property owners. The notices shall state the approved assessment and explain that the owner has thirty (30) days from the date of entry in the unbonded lien docket to pay the full assessment by cash. The notices may also contain an application to pay the assessments in whole or in part on an installment basis, as provided by the Bancroft Bonding Act, ORS 223.205 to 223.300 which is adopted and made a part of this ordinance. The notice may explain that the owner has ten (10) days from receipt of the notice to file with the City the application for Bancroft financing.

Section 2. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
