THE CITY OF LEBANON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. Ordinance No. 1852 prescribing service charges for sewer use is hereby amended as follows:

Section 2. DEFINITIONS, shall be amended to read:
"... or his designated agent.

- (4) New User. New account for which no prior record of water usage is available during January, February, and March as defined for variable "D" in section 3.B.
- (5) Pacific Power and Light Water Service. This statement shall mean either Pacific Power and Light Company's water service prior to 1:00 P.M., November 15, 1984, or City of Lebanon water service after 1:00 P.M., November 15, 1984.
- (6) Schools. ..."

Section 5. ADJUSTMENT OF CHARGES DURING BILLING CYCLE., last paragraph shall be amended to read: "...will not take place until the mext monthly billing after the request is made."

Section 7. PAYMENT OF CHARGES., second paragraph shall be amended to read: "All sewer service charges for the Domestic, Commercial, and School classes shall be due and payable monthly in advance.

All sewer service charges..."

Section 8. COLLECTION OF CHARGES., shall be amended to read: "..., it shall be deemed delinquent and may be recovered by civil action against the property owner, the user, or both. Delinquent accounts which have resulted in termination of water and/or sewer service, as defined in Section 11 of this Ordinance shall draw interest at 12% per annum from the date of termination of service until the account is paid in ful. All sewer service charges accruing..."

Section 11. DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE., first paragraph shall be amended to read: "..., the City shall have the right to discontinue, remove or close sewer connections and/or municipal water service, and enter upon the property for accomplishing such purpose.

The expense..."

Section 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
