WHEREAS, there has been submitted to the City of Lebanon written requests for annexation to the City signed by more than one-half of the landowners who also own more than one-half of the land in the contiguous territory described below, which real property represents more than one-half of the assessed value of all real property in the contiguous territory to be annexed; and

The City Recorder shall also send a description by metes and bounds or legal subdivision, and a map depicting the new boundaries of the City within ten (10) days of the effective date of this annexation to the Linn Councy Assessor, Linn County Clerk and the State Department of Revenue.
