

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING) ORDINANCE BILL NO. 32

DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.)

THE CITY OF LEBANON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Amendment. Chapter 13.20 of the Lebanon Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

Section 13.20.010 Definitions. The definition for "Normal Working Hours" shall be amended to read:

"E. Normal Working Hours. The hours from 8:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M., Monday through Friday, excluding Holidays."

The following new section shall be added to Chapter 13.20 following Section 13.20.330:


13.20.335 Turn-on Charge. A turn-on charge shall be paid to the City whenever water service is turned on by the City at the water meter.

In the case when a customer is unable to turn off the water service for repairs or replacement because of the lack of a customer turn off valve at the meter, the City will turn off the service at the City's meter valve and charge the customer a standard turn-on charge at the time the service is reinstated. The charge will be waived if, while the service is turned off, a customer shut off valve is installed adjacent to the meter by the customer.

If any service is reinstated by anyone other than authorized personnel as defined in Section 13.20.130 the customer shall be billed a standard turn-on charge in addition to any fines which may be brought against any person or persons as defined in Section 13.20.350.


Section 2. Emergency Clause. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
