Section 2. Record. The City Recorder shall submit to the Oregon Secretary of State a copy of this Ordinance. The City Recorder shall also send a description by metes and bounds or legal subdivision, and a map depicting the new boundaries of the City within ten (10) days of the effective date of this annexation to the Linn County Assessor, Linn County Clerk and the State Department of Revenue.

Section 3. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

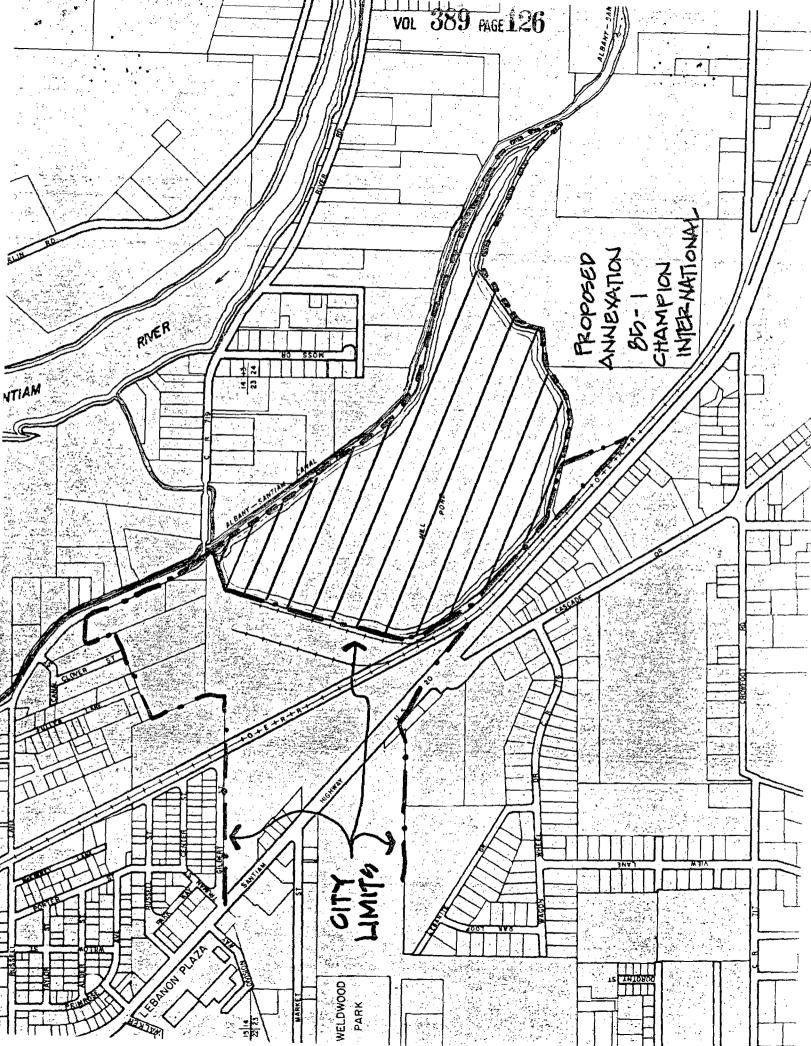
