ORDINANCE BILL NO. 9

ORDINANCE NO. 1993

THE CITY OF LEBANON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a special election be held in the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, on the 24th day of June, 1986, for the purpose of submitting an advisory vote concerning the fluoridation of the City water system.

Section 2. At the special election the following shall be submitted to the legal electors of the City of Lebanon for their approval or rejection:

ADVISORY VOTE CONCERNING FLUORIDATION
OF THE CITY WATER SYSTEM.

Question: Shall the Lebanon City Council implement the fluoridation of the City water system?

Statement: This is an advisory vote to determine the level of public support for the fluoridation of the City water system. Shortly after this election, the City Council will meet to decide this issue.

Section 3. The Recorder of the City of Lebanon is hereby authorized to publish notice of said election in a newspaper of general circulation within the City at least ten (10) days prior to said election; and further he shall place the said measure on the official ballot to be voted on by the legal electors of said election.

Section 4. The polling places for said election in the City of Lebanon shall be those designated by the Linn County Clerk for special elections; the poll books adopted for Lebanon by the Linn County Clerk as the poll books for said election are hereby adopted as the poll

books for the special election; the Judges and Clerks of election appointed by the Linn County Clerk to serve in Lebanon at said election are hereby designated as the Judges and Clerks of and for the City special election.

Section 5. The election shall be conducted by mail, the ballots must be returned to the office of the Linn County Clerk, Linn County Courthouse, Albany, Oregon before 8:00 p.m. June 24, 1986.


Section 6. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

Passed by the Council of the City of Lebanon by a vote of 6 for and 0 against and approved by the Mayor this 14th day of May, 1986.
