ORDINANCE NO. 1998

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon has found that a public need exists to warrant a change in zone; and

WHEREAS, that public need is best met by making a change for this property at this time; and

WHEREAS, public hearings have been held by both the Planning Commission and the City Council in accordance with state and local laws; and

WHEREAS, a "findings" document (attached as exhibit "A" had been adopted,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF LEBANON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. Pursuant to Article 9 of Ordinance No. 1773, the following amendment is made:

Tax Lot 1301 of Assessor's Map 12-2W-10BA is changed from ML, Limited Industrial, to RM, Residential Mixed Density.

Section 2. The Lebanon Zoning Ordinance Map shall be changed to reflect the change as indicated in Section 1.

Section 2. That inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is

hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the City Council and approval by the Mayor.
