THE CITY OF LEBANON ORDAINS AS	FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance # 2009 is hereby repealed. Section 10.44.100 of the Lebanon Municipal Code shall read as follows:

10.44.100 Sidewalk riding prohibited where.

No person shall ride or operate a bicycle or skateboard upon a sidewalk in that area bound by the north line of Vine Street from Park Street to Second; the west line of Second Street from Vine Street to Oak; the south line of Oak Street from Second Street to Main; the west line of Main Street from Oak Street to "A" Street; the east line of Main Street from "A" Street to Oak; the south line of Oak Street from Main Street to Park; and the east line of Park Street from Oak Street to Vine. (Ord. 1819 6(1), 1980).
