ORDINANCE NO. 2021

THE CITY OF LEBANON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Article 2, Section 2.120 NON-VIOLATION PROVISION

- (1) The Planning Official shall not accept an application when he knows that approval of the application would cause violation of any other City ordinance.
- (2) No approval of any use permit, administrative review or other land use decision by the Planning Official, Planning Commission or City Council shall be made if that approval would result in violation of any other City ordinance.

Section 2. That inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the City Council and approval by the Mayor.
