A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 10.44 OF THE LEBANON MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO SIDEWALK SAFETY ORDINANCE BILL NO. for 1988

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. Section 10.44.100 of the Lebanon Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

10.44.100 Sidewalk riding prohibited

- A) No person shall ride or operate a bicycle or skateboard upon a sidewalk in that area bound by the north line of Vine Street from Park Street to Second; the west line of Second Street from Vine Street to Oak; the south line of Oak Street from Second Street to Main; the west line of Main Street from Oak Street to "A" Street; the east line of Main Street from "A" Street to Oak; the south line of Oak Street from Main Street to Park; and the east line of Park Street from Oak Street to Vine. (Ord. 1819 6(1), 1980).
- B) No person shall ride or operate a bicycle or skateboard on side-walks located within the following shopping centers open to the public:
 - 1. Lebanon Plaza
 - 2. Safeway

<u>Section 2</u>. This matter being necessary for the immediate preservation of the health and safety of the People of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
